**The following are standards from the US Postal Service
regarding installation of mail boxes in Maplewood Estates**

- When installing the mailbox post, be certain where utility lines are located prior to digging. Call 1-800-922-1987 to have utility lines located.
- Distance from ground level to the bottom of the mailbox is 42" to 46" and boxes should be level
- In areas with 'attached' sidewalks, the front of the mailbox should not encroach out past the back of the sidewalk. We recommend that the front of the box be placed approx. one foot back from the walk.
- In areas with 'detached' sidewalks, the front of the mailbox should not encroach out past the back of the curb.
- Pair your mailbox with the neighbor's; the only exception to this would be a block with an odd number of lots. The mail trucks go in the same direction as normal traffic, so if you're the first house (on your block) on the right, then you should pair yours with the second. The third house should pair with the fourth and so on. When "pairing", your mailbox post should be set approximately 12" back from the shared property line to ensure that the boxes are separated no more than 3 feet. Two boxes are allowed to share the same post.
- Mailboxes must be 3' to the side of the fire hydrant. Mailboxes must not be put in front of fire hydrants.
